The core vocabulary was determined by identifying all words that were used with a minimal frequency of 0.50%, and that were used by at least half of the participants. The Sepedi core vocabulary consisted of 226 words that accounted for 88.1% of the composite sample. As in other studies, the core vocabulary consisted of a smaller number of words that represent a large proportion of the composite sample. The core word list determined in this study can be used as one resource among others to assist with vocabulary selection for children from a Sepedi language background who may require AAC.
